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Craftsman Snowblower: the useful basics

This compact guide covers general operation and care for the equipment family shown. Controls and procedures vary by model, so locate the complete model number and consult the manufacturer manual before service.

01

Cold starts

Use fresh seasonal fuel and the specified choke and primer sequence. Let the engine stabilize before engaging the auger.

02

Clearing technique

Take smaller passes through deep snow, direct discharge away from people and property, and never reach into the chute.

03

Scraper and auger care

Check scraper wear, skid-shoe height, shear pins, and auger movement before the snow season.

SAFETY FIRST

Stop the engine, remove the key, and disconnect the spark-plug wire before service.
