GE Dryer: the useful basics

This compact guide covers general operation and care for the equipment family shown. Controls and procedures vary by model, so locate the complete model number and consult the manufacturer manual before service.

01

Drying cycles

Use sensor cycles for most laundry and timed drying for loads that do not sense consistently. Separate heavy and lightweight fabrics.

02

Lint and vent care

Clean the lint screen after every load and keep the entire exhaust path clear to reduce drying time and excess heat.

03

Heat troubleshooting

Check airflow and the selected cycle first. Electrical heating-system tests should be performed with the dryer disconnected.

SAFETY FIRST

Let surfaces cool and unplug the dryer before service.
