Generac Generator: the useful basics

This compact guide covers general operation and care for the equipment family shown. Controls and procedures vary by model, so locate the complete model number and consult the manufacturer manual before service.

01

Starting checklist

Check oil, fuel, the air filter, and connected loads before starting. Follow the model-specific choke and switch sequence.

02

Load planning

Add appliances gradually and keep the total running and starting watts within the generator rating.

03

Fuel and filter care

Use fresh approved fuel, inspect the air filter regularly, and follow the storage procedure before long periods of inactivity.

SAFETY FIRST

Operate generators outdoors only, far from openings, and disconnect the spark-plug wire before service.
