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Toro Snowblower: the useful basics

This compact guide covers general operation and care for the equipment family shown. Controls and procedures vary by model, so locate the complete model number and consult the manufacturer manual before service.

01

Cold starts

Use fresh seasonal fuel, set controls as directed, and let the engine stabilize briefly before engaging the auger.

02

Clearing jams

Stop the engine, wait for all movement to stop, and use the clean-out tool. Never use hands in the chute.

03

Belt and auger checks

Inspect belt condition, skid-shoe adjustment, scraper wear, and shear pins before the snow season.

SAFETY FIRST

Stop the engine and disconnect the spark-plug wire before clearing or service.
