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Home Treadmill: the useful basics

This compact guide covers general operation and care for the equipment family shown. Controls and procedures vary by model, so locate the complete model number and consult the manufacturer manual before service.

01

Console basics

Start at low speed, attach the safety key, and change speed or incline gradually. Keep the area behind the deck clear.

02

Belt alignment

A belt that drifts or slips may need small, even rear-roller adjustments. Follow the equipment-specific procedure.

03

Lubrication schedule

Use only the belt lubricant specified for the treadmill. Keep the walking surface clean and inspect for fraying.

SAFETY FIRST

Unplug the treadmill and wait for all movement to stop before service.
